



# What to Expect

- Expect a brief presentation from a member of the **RESCUE PATROL**. The presentation typically lasts up to 15 minutes. You should build this presentation into your schedule for the day of the **RESCUE PATROL**'s visit. You may schedule your visit for any day of your Bible School, however, it is suggested that you do not choose to have your visit on the first day because the schedule for that day is usually very hectic. Register early to ensure that your first choice of date and time is available.
- Expect to receive a VBS Director's Kit complete with instructions and promotional materials. You will receive your Director's Kit in the mail or it will be delivered to your church shortly after you register to participate in the **VBS to the RESCUE** program. Please plan to spend a few moments reviewing the materials so that they can provide you with the most assistance. The more that you promote your Bible School's participation in the program, the more your children will get out of it. We will make it easy for you by providing a church bulletin insert, a parent information letter, posters, and other helpful items.
- Expect to receive practical ideas on how to participate in local mission opportunities through the City Rescue Mission. A member of the **RESCUE PATROL** will share with your Bible School about the services of the Rescue Mission. If time allows, the **RESCUE PATROL** will also endeavor to spend some time with the VBS Director and other church members to explain the many ways that your church can get involved with the City Rescue Mission.
- Expect a chance to capture the traveling **VBS to the RESCUE** trophy. The church that donates the largest offering to the City Rescue Mission will be awarded the **VBS to the RESCUE** trophy for display in your church until the next year's VBS season. The church's name will be engraved on the trophy honoring the great work done by the children of your Bible School.
